THIRD-PARTY DATA BREACHES ARE ON THE RISE

Although an organization can outsource functions to third parties, it cannot outsource **RESPONSIBILITY.**

Companies who outsource anything to a third-party should clearly understand the functions provided by the third party and the risks associated with those functions. ONGOING VENDOR MANAGEMENT POLICY AND REVIEW PROCESS
